Fashion Show Rules & Overview

Recycle Saline: A Solid Waste District is proud to present and host the 5th Annual Re-Fashion Bash “Where Green is the New Black” Recycling Fashion Show. This event will be held on the evening of April 27, 2019 at the Benton Event Center. This event is intended to educate the general public about recycling in a fun and interactive environment. Students of (K-12) are invited to show their created fashion(s) made from recycled materials.

WHO MAY ENTER: Any child in Grades K – 12.

WHERE/WHEN: Saturday, April 27, 2019 at Benton Event Center. Doors open at 5:00pm & Show starts at 6:00 pm.

DIVISIONS: Fashion show contestants shall be judged in the following divisions:

- K – 4th Grade
- 5th Grade – 8th Grade
- 9th Grade – 12th Grade

IMPORTANT DEADLINE DATES:

- 1/14/19- Fashion Show Information meeting at Bauxite High School Auditorium @ 6:00 pm. Address is 800 School St., Bauxite AR 72011. You will enter through the front doors of the main building.
- 1/14/19 – Deadline for consent and release/commitment forms. Forms can be emailed to refashionbash@gmail.com, faxed to 501-776-2553, or brought to the information meeting.
- 2/4/19-2/8/19 – We will be scheduling mentors to go to the schools to help students with their design if they need some guidance. This will be based on permission from the schools.
- 3/25/19 - 3/29/19 – We will be scheduling mentors to go to the schools to help with their design if they need some guidance. This will be based on permission from the schools. This will be the last mentor week.

- 4/8/2019- **Mandatory** Fashion Show Meeting for all participants. Attendance & participation will be considered in the judging process. At least one or all your group members need to be present. In case of an emergency please contact Tiffany at the Recycle Saline Office.
- 4/12/19 – Deadline for everything is due no later than 4:00 pm. Your packet should include the following: consent and release form (Our office will have by January 14), Fashion Designer Information form, a picture of your design, and a picture of hair and make-up.
*note that should you miss a deadline you will need approval to move forward from Recycle Saline.
- 4/27/19- Re-Fashion Bash!!! Doors open at 5:00pm and Fashion Show starts at 6:00pm at Benton Event Center

RULES FOR THE RECYCLE DESIGN:

- The theme for this year’s fashion show is Hollywood! Think your favorite celebrity, movie character, movies, TV shows, books, artists, athletes, or create your own fun character with recycled or reused materials!!
- Think the 3 R’s- Reduce, Reuse, and Recycle.
- Each Design must include these two elements:
 1. Aluminum of any kind (ex. Coke cans, soup cans, foil, etc.)
 2. Cardboard (ex. Cereal boxes, frozen food boxes, regular cardboard box, etc.)
- Recycle designs need to be made of at least 80% recycled or reused materials, 20% can be non-recycling items (new materials).
- The objective is to showcase a recycled design. Only complete designs/outfits will be allowed on the runway. Designs can include other material outside of the required elements such as steel/tin, recycled fabric or clothing*, plastics, paper cartons, newspaper, mixed papers/paper (magazines, junk mail, and catalogs), and paper and plastic bags (ex. grocery bags). New items (20%) may be used in small amounts (ex. small embellishments, duct tape, trash bags).
- Material used to hold the design together such as hot glue, tape, staples etc. aren’t included in your 20% of new items.
- Footwear, jewelry, purses, and other accessories may be used to enhance the overall design, but model must be able to safely walk across the stage and up and down stairs. In any case, safe shoes must be worn whether they are recycled or street shoes.
- *Recycled clothing or fabric may be used, but must be altered to not be worn in its original state, the final product needs to be a transformative creation.
- Duct Tape and trash bags can be used in small amounts but can’t be full design. This type of material would be considered a part of your 20% allowance of new items.

Hair and Make-Up

Benton Beauty Academy has teamed up with us for the fifth year. They will provide hair and make-up for the models the day of the event. It is best that you submit a picture of hair and make-up with your fashion show packet so that Benton Beauty Academy knows in advance what you are wanting. If a picture is not submitted with your packet, they are instructed to do a look they are comfortable with. Hair and make-up will only be done once by the Benton Beauty Academy team. Each model will be responsible for their own touch ups.

JUDGING CRITERIA: All contestants will be judged according to the following areas.

- Mandatory elements (aluminum & cardboard)
- Overall look
- Student Effort
- Environmental message
- Creativity
- Full packet turned in on time
- Completeness, Quality of answers, and legibility of the Fashion Designer Information.
- Mandatory Meeting attendance

JUDGING: Entries will be judged by an impartial panel of judges using the Judging Criteria listed above. During the judging process Models and Designers of the design will be present. One group at a time will go in. Judges will ask each participant the same questions. Example Questions but are not limited to: What is your design made of? What inspired you to create this look? What does recycling mean to you?

PRIZES: Prizes will be awarded to the designer in each category K - 4th, 5th - 8th, 9th - 12th.

- 1st Place: \$500
- 2nd Place: \$300
- 3rd Place: \$100

RULES OF SUBMISSION:

- Up to two designs (2 full looks) per designer can be submitted for judging.
- Up to four (4) group members per group. Submissions must be original, must be the work of the submitting applicant or applicants, and cannot infringe on any copyright, other intellectual property rights, or the rights of privacy or publicity or

- any other right(s) of any third party (best to stay away from prominently displaying company logos unless you can supply written consent).
- Applicants should keep in mind that the fashion show will be held in a public place, and children will be present at the show. Fashions that are offensive, obscene, or too revealing will not be allowed on the runway.
 - Your full Fashion show packet is due no later than April 12, 2019. Your Fashion Show packet includes: consent & release form (I should already have this), fashion designer information packet, a picture of your design, and example picture of hair & make-up.
 - If deadline is missed, you will need to request permission from Recycle Saline staff to move forward.
 - You must turn in a packet for each design (up to two per designer).

DESIGN CONSIDERATIONS: Your design must allow the model to climb a few stairs, walk the stage, and return-back down the stairs to exit. We encourage you to create fashions that are fun, creative, and functional for normal activities.

SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS: Please make sure that materials used in pieces are safe to yourself and to the public.

DESIGNER RESPONSIBILITY: All designers will be responsible for supplying a model for the fashion show, be it themselves, a friend, or other models. Designers/models will be responsible for participation in the fashion show and transportation to and from the Benton Event Center on April 27, 2019. If you need help finding a model, please contact Recycle Saline and we can request one from Oneofakind Talent.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION: By participating, applicants and artists agree that they meet the design specifications. By applying and/or participating, applicants agree to 1.) Abide by official rules and decisions of producers, host, and judges 2.) To hold harmless producers, host, sponsors, employees, volunteers, and others involved in the planning or production of the event from any claims, actions, or demands, losses, damages, or liabilities arising out of their participation in the contest and any related activities 3.) Meet all deadlines laid out for the participants. If a deadline is missed, applicant will need to request approval from Recycle Saline to move forward for participation in the fashion show. 4.) Full packet turned in to Recycle Saline office no later than April 12, 2019 by 4:00pm.

COMMUNICATION: Email will be the only form of communication. Be sure to provide a valid email on your consent and release form and check your email regularly for updates. It is your responsibility to keep up to date with all communication and deadlines. Show producers will only call the phone number provided if we need to contact you individually. DAY OF SHOW

This is a tentative schedule. As we get closer times may adjust, we will inform everyone if times change. We will need all Models and designers at the event center at 10:00am. Runway rehearsal will begin promptly at 10:30 am and hair and make-up will begin right after. Fashion Show will begin at 6:00 pm. Lunch, snacks, and water are available for the volunteers, designers, and models that are participating in the fashion show.

- What to Expect:
 - 10:00 am- Models and Designers arrive and begin to settle in
 - 10:30 am- Runway Rehearsal Begins (not in design)
(All models that will be walking the runway will need to be present for rehearsal)
 - 12:15 pm- Lunch, Hair and Make-Up with Benton Beauty Academy will begin
- Order of Hair and Make-Up:
- 1st group- 9th-12th grade
 - 2nd group- 5th-8th grade
 - 3rd group- K-4th grade group
- Photo will be taken in design as soon as hair and make-up are finished
- 2:00 pm- Start Lining up for judging
 - 1st group- 9th-12th grade
 - 2nd group- 5th-8th grade
 - 3rd group- K-4th grade
 - 2:30 pm - 4:30 pm- Judging Begins
 - 5:00 pm- Doors Open and Line Up begins
 - 6:00 pm- Show Starts
